<b>124. SUMMER SCHOOL</b>	
<p>1. Purpose SC 502, 1901 Title 22 Sec. 5.211</p> <p>2. Authority SC 1901, 1906</p> <p>3. Guidelines</p>	<p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of instruction for resident students of this district.</p> <p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Employ teaching and administrative staff;</li><li>2. Purchase such books, materials, supplies, and equipment as may be necessary;</li><li>3. Utilize school or other facilities as required; and</li><li>4. Provide necessary custodial services.</li></ol> <p>Tuition fees shall be charged to all students who participate and shall be set by the Board.</p> <p>Discipline and attendance infractions at summer school shall not be tolerated. All school rules and regulations shall be in effect for summer school.</p> <p><u>Attendance</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Vacations, camping trips, job interviews, etc., are not considered legal absences.</li><li>2. More than one (1) medical absence or one (1) non-medical absence, regardless of reason, will result in withdrawal from the session and the fee forfeited.</li><li>3. One (1) tardy, regardless of the length of time or reason, will be counted as an absence. More than one (1) tardy will result in withdrawal from the session and the fee forfeited.</li></ol> <p><u>Discipline Infractions</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Use or possession of tobacco products, alcohol or drugs will not be tolerated. Offenders shall be withdrawn from the session and the fee forfeited. The offender may be turned over to the police.</li></ol>

2. Fighting and/or vandalism will not be tolerated. Offenders will be withdrawn from the session and the fee forfeited.
3. Minor rule violations, such as talking out and/or disturbing others, shall be dealt with as follows:
  - A. One (1) verbal warning by staff.
  - B. One (1) written warning.
  - C. Withdrawal from the session and fee forfeited.
4. Edible materials and beverages permitted at teacher discretion.
5. All trash items shall be placed in the trash containers.
