Guidelines</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>140.1 EXTRA-CURRICULAR/CO-CURRICULAR PARTICIPATION BY CHARTER/CYBER CHARTER STUDENTS</b></p> <p>The board shall approve participation in the district’s extra-curricular/co-curricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs by a student enrolled in a charter or cyber charter school if all of the following conditions are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The student is a resident of the school district.</li> <li>2. The charter or cyber charter school does not provide the same extra-curricular/co-curricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.</li> <li>3. The student fulfills all eligibility criteria required for participation in an activity by district students, in accordance with Board Policy 122- Extra-curricular/Co-Curricular Activities and/or Policy 123- Interscholastic Athletics.</li> </ol> <p>The board shall not provide individual transportation for students enrolled in charter or cyber charter schools who participate in the district’s extra-curricular/co-curricular activities or interscholastic athletic programs. When the district provides transportation to and from an away competition, game, event or exhibition and requires district students to use district transportation, charter or cyber charter students shall be required to use the transportation provided by the district.</p> <p>Charter or cyber charter school students shall be given an equal opportunity to compete for positions and participate in district extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs.</p> <p>A charter or cyber charter school student may participate only in extra-curricular/co-curricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs at the school building the student would be assigned to if he or she was enrolled in the school district.</p> <p>Prior to trying-out or joining an activity, a charter or cyber charter school student shall submit required documents and written verification of eligibility to the building principal or designee.</p>
