125. ADULT EDUCATION	
<p>1.Purpose SC 502, 1901</p>	<p>The Board recognizes the continuing interests of adult members of the community in educational growth and advancement and the need of both adults and minors for learning programs not available to them in the regular program of the schools.</p>
<p>2.Authority SC 1906 Title 22 Sec. 5.222</p>	<p>The Board shall establish and maintain a program of adult education to provide instruction in civic, vocational, homemaking and technical. Such program of studies shall be based on the educational needs of the persons eligible for admission to it and shall conform to the standards of the State Board of Education.</p>
<p>SC 1903, 1923</p>	<p>The Board will employ staff, utilize existing facilities, provide custodial services, when applicable, provide counseling and guidance services, when applicable, and provide administrative leadership as required for the maintenance of the adult education program.</p>
<p>SC 1905</p>	<p>The Board authorizes the award of high school diplomas and recognition for skills or accomplishments in accordance with state regulations.</p> <p>Admission to the adult education program shall be open to all adult residents of this district, and such adult residents of other districts as apply and whose admittance will not deprive a district resident of admittance.</p>
<p>SC 1904</p>	<p>The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to establish the tuition rate for each course offered in the adult education program. Exception to tuition shall be made for senior residents of the district who are 62 years of age or older, who shall be admitted to the adult education program at reduced rate.</p>
<p>3.Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall utilize appropriate staff members and assess the needs and resources of the community to develop a program of adult education and present that program to the Board for their approval.</p> <p>Such programs shall be consistent with the policies and goals of this Board.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall prepare a calendar of adult school activities</p>
