	<p>202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS</p>
<p>1.Purpose SC 501</p>	<p>The Board shall operate the schools of this district for the benefit of children resident in this district and eligible for attendance.</p>
<p>SC 1301</p>	<p>The Board may permit the admission of nonresident students in accordance with terms of this policy.</p>
<p>SC 1302</p>	<p>The Board reserves the right to verify the residency of any student and to require a notarized sworn statement of residential support for the student who resides with a person other than his/her parent, guardian or custodian.</p>
<p>2.Authority</p>	<p>A. <u>Nonresident Children Placed In The District</u></p>
<p>SC 1305</p>	<p>Any child placed in the home of a resident of this district by a court or an agency of government shall be admitted to the schools and shall receive the same benefits and be subject to the same duties as resident children.</p>
	<p>B. <u>Inmates Of Institutions</u></p>
<p>SC 1306-9</p>	<p>A child who is an inmate of an institution for the care or training of children located within this district, is not a legal resident of the district by such placement, but shall be admitted to the schools of this district and a charge shall be made for tuition in accordance with statute.</p>
<p>C.</p>	<p><u>Former Residents</u></p> <p>Regularly enrolled children whose parents have moved out of the school district may be permitted to finish the school term without payment of tuition, provided that the parents move from the district during the last nine (9) weeks immediately previous to the end of the school term. If the student is in the 12th grade and the parents move from the district during the semester immediately previous to the end of the school year, the student may complete the year.</p> <p>Regularly enrolled children whose parents move from the district at any time during</p>
