CLASS RANK</p> <p>The Board acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing grade point averages and class ranking for secondary school graduates to inform students, parents and others of their relative academic placement among their peers under relatively similar circumstances.</p> <p>The Board authorizes a system of class ranking, by grade point average, for students in grades 9 12. All students shall be ranked together.</p> <p>Class rank shall be computed by the final grade in all subjects.</p> <p>A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on his/her record and shall be subject to the Board's policy on release of student records.</p> <p>Rank in class shall be entered on students' records and on all transcripts where they will be available for review by authorized persons.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the computation of grade point averages and the assignment of rank in class to implement this policy which shall include a determination of class rank for students graduating before their class and a statement of the methods for such computation and assignment to be made available for those to whom a student's grade point average or rank in class is released.</p>
