CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY</p> <p>The Board believes that the schools should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.</p> <p>The Board charges each student in the schools of this district with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.</p> <p>A student shall not steal, attempt to steal, intentionally cause damage to, or attempt to cause damage to district-owned property or property owned by district employes or <u>elected officials</u>, off school premises and after school hours, when such conduct: (1) results in an adverse effect on the educational process; (2) results in an adverse effect on school discipline; or (3) threatens the health, safety or welfare of the other students, employes, <u>and elected officials</u>.</p> <p>The Board may report to the appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property has been serious or chronic in nature. <u>Parents and guardians of students shall be held accountable for student actions.</u></p> <p>In no case shall such referral to juvenile authorities be made without prior notification to the student's parent.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- rules for the safekeeping and accounting of text books, supplies and equipment;</li> <li>- preparation of a schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies and equipment; and a report to the Board annually on the incidence of vandalism, which report shall include the number and kind of incident, the cost of vandalism to the district, and such related facts and comments as the Superintendent may wish to make. The report shall be made to the Superintendent within a 24-hour period.</li> </ul>
