711. PARKING AND TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board recognizes the responsibility of the district to provide for the safety of students, employees and visitors as pedestrians and motorists who use the roadways, parking areas and grounds located at the schools in the district.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 779 75 Pa. C.S.A. Sec. 3353</p>	<p>In accordance with law, the district shall provide for the orderly and safe flow of traffic, pedestrian walkways and nonparking areas and the enforcement of applicable laws and rules and regulations by designated district personnel.</p> <p>The Board shall impose a speed limit of 15 mph on all roadways, pedestrian crosswalks and parking areas located at all the schools in the district.</p> <p>Traffic control devices such as stop signs, roadway markings, speed limit signs, no parking signs, and other traffic control devices approved by the Board shall be installed in compliance with this policy under the supervision of the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds/Maintenance.</p> <p>Students, employees and visitors must strictly adhere to all signs and traffic control devices or be subject to the penalties set forth by the district.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility  SC 779</p>	<p>The superintendent or his/her designee shall develop parking/traffic rules and regulations for the district.</p> <p>The Board authorizes and directs designated district personnel to enforce traffic and parking regulations of the district.</p> <p>District police officers shall possess the authority and powers vested in them as provided by law.</p> <p><b><u>REFERENCES</u></b></p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
