45% TESTS & QUIZZES

You will have a unit test at the end of each chapter. You will also have a quiz in the middle of the unit. *IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO STUDY*. Tests are not curved.

5% PARTICIPATION

If you do not speak in the language, it is hard to learn the language effectively. You will need to repeat vocabulary after me in order that you can learn how to pronounce the words. We will repeat vocabulary A LOT! You also will have several opportunities to raise your hand in class.

5% BEHAVIOR

You are expected to have mature behavior. You are also expected to be respectful of the teacher and your classmates. If you question whether or not something is mature, do not risk it. *You have freedom of choice, but not freedom of consequence.*

15% FOLDER

During the course of the year, you will keep a folder specifically for Spanish. This will consist of everything we do during the year. Each paper that we complete in class will have a number. I will tell you the number as we go along and you will place them in your folder. The only papers that do NOT have numbers are homework and tests. At the end of the marking period, I will give you a table of contents and you will hand in your folder. It is important to keep your folder ORGANIZED!
