It is our hope that these resources will support the health, behavior, and achievement of every student that participates. The success in this program in other areas has shown positive changes in attendance, behaviors, and grades.

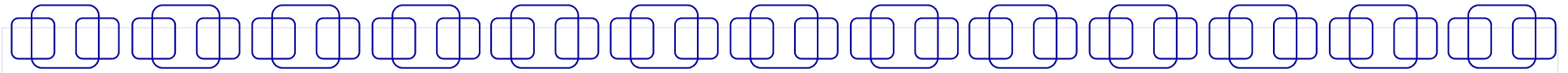

Our Focus:

Children can have dedicated teachers, new books, and the latest technology, but without proper nutrition, they won't be able to focus on the day's lessons.

The Golden Eagle Backpack Program puts our kids at the front of the line for receiving the food they need while not in school, food that equips them to come to school Monday morning physically and mentally prepared to learn.



How it Works:

What We Do?

Distribute free meals to children in need for weekends during the school year that may include breakfasts, lunches, dinners, drinks, and snacks.

How Children are Selected?

School personnel may recommend a child for the program. Parents can also enroll by contacting the Middle School Office at 684-4932. A Parent/Guardian must opt-in to the program for their child(ren) to receive the food. Opt-in forms are also available electronically at www.northernblairbackpacks.org on the school's website at www.tyrone.k12.pa.us.

Who is Eligible?

The program is intended to help those children who have difficulty accessing food outside of school. Eligibility is not income based.

Who Packs the Bags?

All the work is done by volunteers. The names of all children enrolled in the program are kept confidential from all volunteers of the program.

Where Does the Program Operate?

The Golden Eagle Backpack Program is currently being provided to Tyrone Area Elementary students. Food is delivered, packed, and distributed to the classrooms of students at the Tyrone Area Elementary school.

How is the Program Supported?

The program is supported through monetary donations and targeted food donations.

Approximately \$3.00 feeds 1 student for a weekend, \$100 for the whole school year, through this program.
