212. REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS	
1. Purpose Pol. 216	The Board believes that cooperation between school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of each student. The Board acknowledges the school's responsibility to keep parents/guardians informed of student welfare and academic progress and also recognizes the effects of state and federal laws and regulations governing student records.
2. Authority	<p>The Board directs establishment of a system of reporting student progress that requires all appropriate staff members to comply, as part of their teaching responsibility, with a reporting system which may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Student Information Management Systems; B. Academic progress reports; C. Report cards; and D. Parent/guardian conferences with teachers.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The superintendent or designee, in conjunction with appropriate staff members, shall develop procedures for reporting student progress to parents/guardians.
4. Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Various methods of reporting appropriate to grade level and curriculum content shall be utilized. B. Both student and parent/guardian shall receive ample warning of a pending grade of failure, or one that would adversely affect the student's academic status. C. Scheduling of parent-teacher conferences should occur at times that ensure the greatest degree of participation by parents/guardians. D. Report cards shall be issued at intervals of not less than nine (9) weeks. E. Review and evaluation of methods of reporting student progress to parents/guardians shall be conducted on a periodic basis.
