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## Course

### Description

7<sup>th</sup> Grade Intro to Art is a semester-long course designed to introduce students to the foundations of Visual Arts and the techniques of rendering in both a two-dimensional and three-dimensional space.

Students will learn:

Various techniques working in art mediums (pencil, clay, paint)

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Vocab associated with two-dimensional and three-dimensional design

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The production of functional and non-functional art

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The foundations of drawing and perspective

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To develop your own personal and artistic way of creating
